Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: This is a composite building with two main parts. The east part is an early C19 three storey building with a three window east front and rounded angle to one window north front. Painted brick with low parapet. Gauged flat brick arches to sash windows, those on first floor with glazing bars, those on second floor replaced, with margin lights. Modern shops on ground floor.

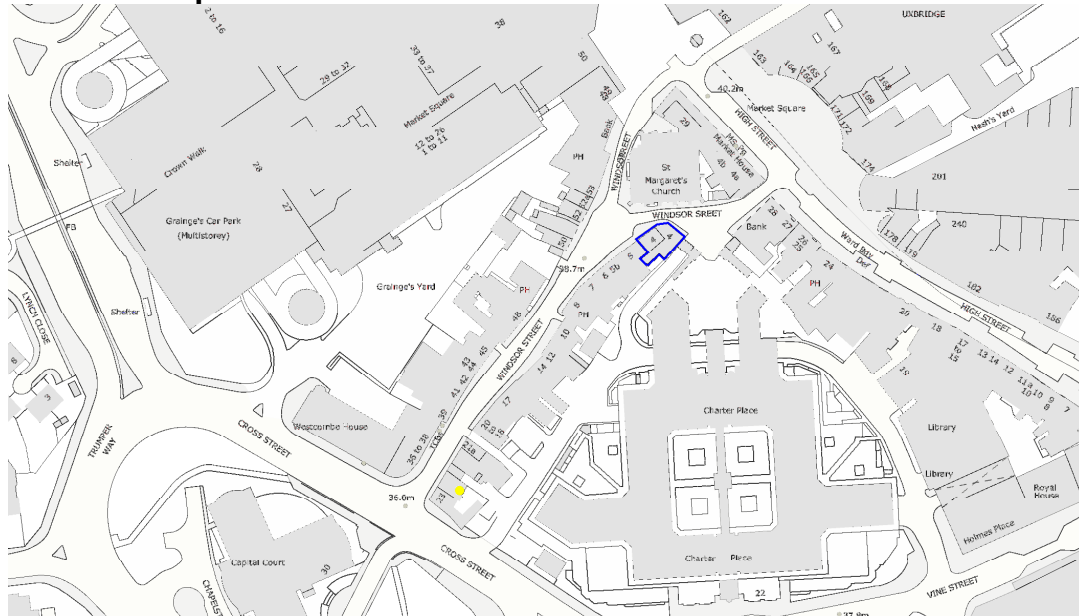
The north part is a two-storey, three bay irregular building probably timber framed and

of C17 origin but altered. High pitched tiled roof and painted brick front. One C19 sash window in exposed moulded frame under gauged brick arch at right, one modern three light casement and a blocked window at left. Modern shop on ground floor.

Townscape: Key landmark on Windsor Street, contributes to local character and street scene.
