


DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT and MAP

To the London Borough of Hillingdon, Rights of Way,

1. We, The Masters and Wardens of the Merchant Taylors of the Fraternity of St John Baptists in the City of London of Merchant Taylors Hall, 30 Threadneedle Street, London EC2R 8JB are and have been since 9 of July 1991 the owners within the meaning of the above section of the Highways Act 1980 of the land known as St Johns School, Potter Street Hill, Northwood, Middlesex HA6 3QY more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this statement and thereon edged red.
2. The ways coloured purple on the said plan have been dedicated as footpaths
3. No other ways over the land have been dedicated as highways.
4. The deposit shall comprise this statement and accompanying map.



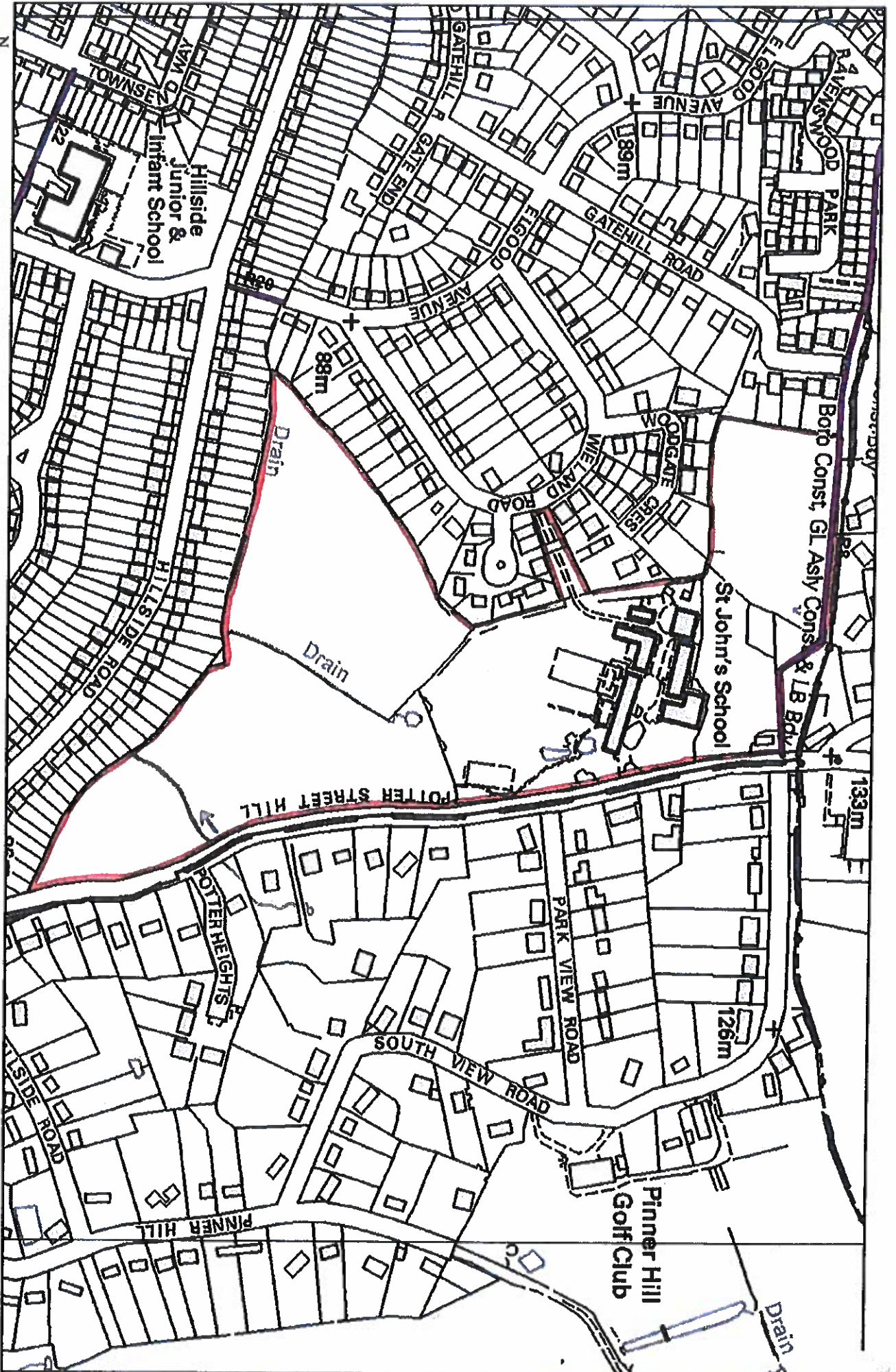

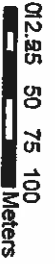

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STATUTORY DECLARATION


SECTION 31 (6) of the HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

We, The Masters and Wardens of the Merchant Taylors of the Fraternity of St John Baptists in the City of London of Merchant Taylors Hall of 30 Threadneedle Street, London EC2R 8JB DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. We are and have been since 9 July 1991 the owners of the land known as St Johns School, Potter Street Hill, Northwood, Middlesex HA6 3QY, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red.
2. On the 25th January 2013 we deposited with the London Borough of Hillingdon, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured in purple on the said plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 19 December 2012 referred to in 2 above other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plans accompanying this declaration and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over our property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 11 April 2013 conscientiously believing the same to be true by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
