Hillingdon Stroke Support Group

Hillingdon Stroke Support Group are a Stroke Association Volunteer Group for stroke survivors in Hillingdon. The group provides a space for people to attend, share their story and receive respite. During their meetings, the group provides stroke recovery activities, focusing on hand-eye coordination, speech therapy, memory and mathematics. They also host weekly quizzes, encouraging a friendly atmosphere of competition.

Additional support needs often arise and the group provides person-centred care by initiating contact with other organisations and charities, to help members overcome technological, communication and travel barriers.

The main aim of the Stroke Association is to reduce the number of strokes that happen, by furthering medical research and improving the lifestyles of individuals at risk.

SEND Family Support Hillingdon

SEND Family Support Hillingdon was founded in September 2015, and gained its charitable status in 2019.

The charity's group of volunteers and carers runs events and forums for families caring for children with SEND.

At their events, children have fun and their carers can socialise, network, share information, support each other and discuss services they may need for their families.

The group also hosts monthly drop in sessions at Mencap Hillingdon South in Harlington. The DADZ4DADZ and MUMZ4MUMZ closed social media platforms provide inclusive support for families too.
